2+8 shut the gate (mime)

1+9 We're all fine (thumbs up)

0+10 let's start again.

Whisper and shout:

Count in 1s, 2s, or 10s. Whisper and shout alternative multiples. 1 2 3 4 5 6 2 4 6 8 10. (count until 12x)

Activities for year 1 Spring 1:

Whisper and shout:

Throw to me:

Have an object that can be thrown, throw the object to a child they then have to answer a question that you give them.

Examples: continue the sequence-give 6, 8, 10, can they finish it?

What is it? Give children missing number calculations ie 7+__=10 what is double 8? (doubles to 20)

This term the 5x has also been added and doubles are doubles to 20. Remember when looking at counting go to at least 12x the number, forwards and backwards

Examples: continue the sequence-give 6, 8, 10, can they finish it?

What is it? Give children missing number calculations ie $7+_$ =10 what is double 8? (doubles to 20)

Round the world:

Play 'Round the world' counting in 1s and 10s. Children sit in a circle. Two children stand up and are asked a question, eg 10, 20, 30, 40 what comes next? The first to answer stays standing up. Buzz off:

Show me:

See year 1, Spring 1. But up this to number bonds to 20 and missing numbers to 50.

Throw to me:

See Year 1 Spring 1.

Round the world:

Play 'Round the world' counting in 1s and 10s. Children sit in a circle. Two children stand up and are asked a question, eg 10, 20, 30, 40 what comes next? The first to answer stays standing up. The next pair of children stand up and are asked a question. Again, the first to answer stays standing. Repeat until all pairs have been asked a question. Standing winners are given a round of applause.

Forwards and back:

Hold the number of fingers count in front as you count. For counting in 2s, each multiple hold out 2 fingers. Count in 2s, 5s, 10s to at least 12x the number- aiming to get as close to 100 as possible.

Clapping multiples:

Children to face partner, clap their hands with partners hands whilst counting in wither 2s, 5s, or 10s- Counting to at least 12x the number.

Counting from any number, forwards and backwards-going to the 100 and past.

Show me:

See year 1, Spring 1. But up this to number bonds to 20 and missing numbers to 50 and $\frac{1}{2}$ of numbers to 20.

Throw to me:

See Year 1 Spring 1.

Round the world:

Play 'Round the world' counting in 1s and 10s. Children sit in a circle. Two children stand up and are asked a question, eg 10, 20, 30, 40 what comes next? The first to answer stays standing up. The next pair of children stand up and are asked a question. Again, the first to answer stays standing. Repeat until all pairs have been asked a question. Standing winners are given a round of applause.

Forwards and back:

Hold the number of fingers count in front as you count. For counting in 2s, each multiple hold out 2 fingers. Count in 2s, 5s, 10s to at least 12x the number- aiming to get as close to 100 as possible.

Clapping multiples:

Children to face partner, clap their hands with partners hands whilst counting in wither 2s, 5s, or 10s- Counting to at least 12x the number.
